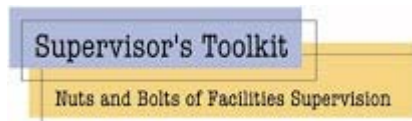

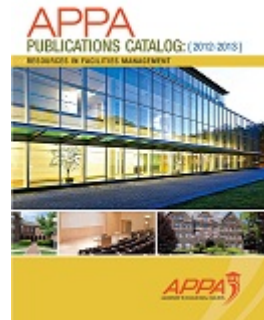

BYU Facilities Management Student and Cal State-Fullerton Prof Win First Annual Real Estate Faculty and Student Writing Competition

A student pursuing a degree in Facility and Property Management at Brigham Young University (BYU) and a professor from California State University-Fullerton have been named winners of the first annual writing competition to promote scholarship in the field of real estate property and asset management sponsored jointly by the Institute of Real Estate Management and the IREM Foundation. The winning student submission was authored by Nick Gonzalves of BYU and titled "Social Media and Property Management." U Iowa Stuit Hall Renovation Earns LEED Gold

Stuit Hall, which serves as a hub for the University of Iowa (UI) clinical psychology program has earned Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) gold certification from the U.S. Green Building Council. The building

incorporates passive solar design, a rain garden to capture stormwater from the roof, occupancy sensors to control electric lights, new insulation and windows, low-VOC and formaldehyde-free products, energy-efficient mechanicals, and recycling storage and collection centers on every floor.
