presentation entitled "Speaking the CFO Language" at the 10th Annual Energy/Facilities Connections Conference in Leavenworth, WA. In it she emphasized the need for facilities managers to know the numbers as a baseline for improvement, fiscal responsibility, and leverage in working with their institution's chief financial officers. She offered tips to getting budget approval for energy, custodial, and facility projects by emphasizing metrics - Key Performance Indicators or Facility Performance Indicators - sought by chief financial officers. She noted facility mangers need self-discipline to proactively "dig" and get first-hand knowledge of factors including cost per square foot, ROIs for purchases, total cost of ownership, and staffing levels and costs. Knowledge of how to meet stakeholder needs in a dollars-and-cents paradigm based on carefully developed, controlled-message surveys is also essential. This summary provides highlights of the insights delivered.

National College Competition Saves 3 Million Pounds of CO2 and 476,000 Gallons of Water

Student Behavior Changes Make Big Impact During Campus Conservation Nationals 2014

Lucid, the Center for Green Schools at the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC), the National Wildlife Federation, and the Alliance to Save Energy announced that more than 265,000 students at 109 colleges and universities across the U.S. and Canada collectively saved more than 2.2 million kilowatt-hours of electricity — equivalent to averting 3 million pounds of CO2 from the atmosphere and saving \$196,000 through the Campus Conservation Nationals 2014 contest. This year, students also saved nearly 476,000 gallons of water, or the equivalent of 1.8 million water bottles.

- The top 10 schools in electricity reduction were Appalachian State
 University, Bard College, Berea College, California State University
 Chico, Dickinson College, Louisiana State University, Loyola
 University Maryland, Portland State University, Wake Forest
 University, and Western Carolina University, with an average energy
 reduction of 17.2 percent.
- The top five schools in water reduction were Oberlin College, Pomona College, University of California Santa Barbara, University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, and Wake Forest University, with range of reduction of 4 to 17 percent.

Conventional Online Higher Education Will Absorb MOOCs, Two Reports Say

Massive open online courses will not fundamentally reshape higher education, nor will they disappear altogether. Those are the conclusions of separate reports released this week by Teachers College at Columbia University and Bellwether Education Partners, a nonprofit advisory group. Neither report contains any blockbuster news for those who have followed

the decline of the MOOC hype over the last year or so. But they support the theory that the tools and techniques Stanford University professors used in 2011 to enroll 160,000 students in a free, online computer-science course will be subsumed by broader, incremental efforts to improve higher education with technology.
