

UMass Amherst's Iconic Old Chapel Nominated to National Register of Historic Places

The University of Massachusetts Amherst's iconic Old Chapel, which is about to undergo major renovations after years of disuse, has been nominated for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The Massachusetts Historical Commission reported that it believes the building meets the criteria for the federal recognition for both its historic and its architectural significance. The Old Chapel, designed in the Romanesque Revival style, was completed in 1885. Its

granite and brownstone exterior and its position overlooking the Campus Pond have made it the unofficial symbol of the Commonwealth's flagship campus. Over its history it served as classroom building, library, auditorium, museum, and chapel and was home to the UMass Minuteman Marching Band until it was deemed unsafe in 1996. Plans are under way to renovate and reopen the facility. Under the renovation plan,

the chapel's top floor will provide a large open space for performances and lectures and will be available for weddings and similar events. The multi-purpose first floor will provide a flexible layout for displays, events, and will serve as a

general campus resource. The basement will hold utilities, a kitchen facility, and restrooms. <u>Learn more</u>.



Big 10 and Friends Mechanical and Energy Conference

The University of Iowa will host the 2014 Big 10 and Friends Mechanical and Energy Conference, which will take place October 12-15 at the Iowa City campus. When participants arrive to attend they will see and feel nearly \$1.2 billion in construction projects underway, a pace unprecedented in the University of Iowa's 166-year history and on scale with a city the size of Minneapolis. The relocation and replacement of three major Arts Campus buildings damaged during the flood of 2008, and a number of other new projects including the University of Iowa Children's Hospital, Pappajohn Biomedical Discovery Building, West Campus Residence Hall and the Football Operations Complex, make this an exciting and pivotal time to visit the campus. WMU Sangren Hall Earns LEED Gold

Western Michigan University's (WMU's) Sangren Hall has just been awarded LEED Gold certification by the U.S. Green Building Council. Home to the College of Education and Human Development and the Department of Sociology, the 230,000-square-foot Sangren Hall was completed in 2012 at a

cost of just under \$60 million. Sitting at the center of the WMU campus, Sangren is one of the University's most heavily used classroom buildings. It has more than four dozen classrooms, thousands of instructional seats, and a large grants and research center as well as clinical and office space for several programs. Since its opening, the building has been recognized with more than a half dozen design and construction awards. Peter Strazdas, WMU associate vice president for facilities management, and APPA president-elect, notes that Sangren was built with the goal of achieving LEED gold certification, and

even after its 2012 opening, major sustainability features were added to complete the building's green qualities. Strazdas calls the facility one of the most energy efficient on the campus and in the state of Michigan. Learn more.
