

New Look for the Campus Environmental Resource Center Website

The Campus Environmental Resource Center (ERC) was established to provide individuals and educational institutions with the knowledge and tools to maintain environmental regulatory compliance, improve management, and operate sustainably. The ERC website has undergone significant upgrades. Whatever your role on a campus, this revitalized site can be a great resource. The upgrade impacts two major areas:

- 1. The site has been updated and configured for use in different devices types. Content can now be viewed on a standard computer, laptop, tablet, or smartphone.
- 2. Content headings have been limited to allow you quicker access to critical information. The home page can be browsed by the updated Campus Tour (which links to physical parts of campus buildings), Topics, Compliance Guide links, News and Updates, Resources, and a newly added item, "Your Role on Campus."



The "Your Role on Campus" option includes separate subheadings for access of information by those in Admin/Leadership, EHS, Facilities, Educators, Students, and K-12. NACUBO/APPA Key Facilities Metrics Survey

Where measurements occur, then improvements are likely to follow. The National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO) and APPA are collaborating to raise consciousness over some basic key facilities metrics. The goal is for campus finance and facilities professionals to be in alignment on a handful of important annual consumption metrics, such as energy, water consumption, and waste stream output. This brief six-question survey requires you to enter data on your campus' annual consumption (found on utility/vendor monthly or quarterly) statements. While this requires some minimal effort, knowing this information should prove most beneficial for both facilities and financial strategic leadership.

Colleges and Universities Invited to Compete in GameDay Recycling Challenge

College football fans meet the challenge to reduce stadium waste.

GameDay Recycling Challenge invites colleges and universities across the nation to compete to see which school will produce the least amount of waste in its stadiums and tailgate areas this college football season. Participating schools identify one or more games to report the amount of material diverted through recycling, composting, and via food donations versus the amount thrown away. Winners for each athletic conference will be recognized, with five different categories per conference. National winners will be recognized in two categories: 1) total amount recycled, composted, and donated; and 2) diversion rate – or the percentage of waste diverted from the landfill. Registered competitors represent 15 athletic conferences, including the Big Ten, Big 12, and Ivy League. Colleges and universities are invited to accept the Challenge by registering on GameDayChallenge.org by Sept. 30.

ASHRAE Supports Change to NCEES Education Initiative

A move by United States engineering and surveying licensing boards to remove a requirement for an additional 30 credit hours for obtaining licensure as a Professional Engineer is met with approval by ASHRAE. In 2006, the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) approved language in its model law requiring the additional 30 hours – roughly the equivalent of a master's degree – to obtain a P.E. license. The requirement was slated to take effect in 2020. At its 2014 annual meeting held Aug. 20-23, NCEES voted to modify that approach, and instead develop an official NCEES position statement that supports additional engineering education beyond a bachelor's degree. The move was applauded by ASHRAE and other industry associations who had opposed the effort over the last eight years. Learn more.

Johns Hopkins University Reducing Energy Costs and Carbon with On-Site Utility

New Energy System Part of Campus GHG Reduction Plan

A leading on site utility, offering clean electricity, heat, hot water, and cooling solutions to hospitality, healthcare, housing and athletic facilities, is now operating a 75 kW combined heat and power (CHP) system providing an on-site energy solution to Wolman Hall student housing at The Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, Maryland. Through this Purchase of Power Agreement, Wolman Hall will receive a portion of its electricity and hot water from a 75 kW CHP system, which is owned and operated by the energy company. The University receives a guaranteed discount on the energy produced by the CHP system while reducing their carbon footprint and is only paying for the energy produced while they avoided all capital, installation, and maintenance costs. The CHP system will produce up to 592,000 KWh of electricity and 3,900 million BTU of useable heat annually in the form of hot water. Utilizing a highly efficient CHP unit, Johns Hopkins will offset up to 415 tons of CO2 per year.

The new CHP system at Wolman Hall is part of the University's commitment reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 51% by 2025. <u>Learn more</u>.
