

Forecasts are in on expected weather conditions for this winter. What we can expect:


- The North Central will not face the bitter cold of last year and will receive average snowfall

Bowling Green State U Building Earns LEED Gold

The Oaks dining center at Bowling Green State University in Ohio is the latest building on campus to receive recognition for its green design. The Oaks was awarded Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Gold status by the U.S. Green Building Council and verified by the Green Building Certification Institute. This is BGSU's fourth LEED-certified

building. LEED is the nation's preeminent program for design, construction, and operation of high-performance green buildings. The dining center was built with sustainability in mind. Seventy-five percent of the construction waste was recycled; all building materials



used were purchased within a 500-mile radius; Ohio barn wood was utilized in the flooring, millwork, and wall treatments, and the construction used less structural steel. Learn more.

Institutions that rely solely on a traditional business approach are unlikely to thrive; they must identify and seize new opportunities in pursuit of their mission. Alliance to Pursue Long-Term Greenhouse Gas Reduction Goal **Announcement Made During White House Roundtable** Is your refrigeration management strategy designed to mitigate any environmental effects?

The Alliance for Responsible Atmospheric Policy has announced support for policies and actions with a goal to reduce global hydrofluorocarbon (HFC) emissions by 80 percent by 2050. The Alliance is an industry coalition representing more than 95 percent U.S. HFC production and a significant majority of the user industries. The announcement was made during an industry leadership roundtable coinciding with International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Laver. The event convened representatives from system manufacturers, end users, and fluorocarbon producers in a roundtable briefing of Obama Administration officials. The Alliance believes a global approach under the Montreal Protocol, the 1987 treaty adopted to address depletion of the Earth's ozone layer, provides the best forum with established institutions to deal with the technical complexities of reducing global emissions of HFCs while maintaining the phase-out of ozone depleting substances such as HCFCs.
