Center for Green Schools at USGBC Publishes 2013 Report Card

The U.S. Building Council's Center for Green Schools works directly with the people who have the biggest stake in our children's education – parents, school leaders, students, educators, and elected officials – to implement measurable, sustainable, and scalable improvements in schools across the world. The Center's Report Cards show how the organization is measuring up to its own goals to accelerate the transformation of all schools into healthy, safe, and efficient places that inspire great learning: <http://www.centerforgreenschools.org/reportcard>.

Boston U Medical Student Residence Receives LEED Gold

Boston University's new Medical Student Residence building has received LEED Gold status. Highlights of the building's sustainable design features include:

- **Green Roof:** White reflective roofing is used to minimize the urban heat island effect and reduce energy use.
- **Water Efficiency:** Water use in the building has been reduced by 40% through the installation of features such as low-flow kitchen and lavatory faucets and showers.
- **Irrigation Water Use:** The residence uses high-efficiency irrigation technology, using recycled rain water, and drought-tolerant landscaping to reduce potable water consumption for irrigation. The landscape features were designed to require as little water as possible and the residence uses 100% rainwater harvesting for irrigation, resulting in an 11% reduction in water used for irrigation.
- **Energy Efficiency:** Building energy efficiency is a high priority for new building design for Boston University. The Medical Student Residence is 18% more efficient than building code requirements. Some of the energy efficiency features include improved thermal envelope, high-efficiency windows, reduced lighting power, efficient heating equipment, energy recovery, and elevators with regenerative drives.

Major Contract Flooring Study Taking Place

The Commissioning of the 5th Edition of The North American Market for Contract Flooring has been announced. This report will present a comprehensive analysis of replacement and installation activity in existing buildings as well as new buildings by establishment type and region.
