

Life Science Laboratories at UMass Amherst Honored for Landscape Architecture by SCUP

The Society for College and University Planning (SCUP) has awarded an Excellence in Landscape Architecture for General Design Honor to the

University of Massa chusetts Amherst for its Life Science Laboratories (LSL). SCUP recognizes exemplary planning, design, and implementation of firms, institutions, and individuals. A state-of-the-art facility that opened in fall 2013, the Life Science Laboratories (LSL) has a variety of flexible lab spa ces for interdisciplinary research. It earned LEED Gold certification. The LSL has many sustainably related features:



- The facilities daylight shelves, demand controlled ventilation, heat recovery system, and exterior shading allow it to use 33 percent less energy than comparable buildings.
- The LSL was developed to reduce water usage by 49 percent with lowflow fixtures and reclaimed water from sewage conveyance.
- During LSL's construction, 81 percent of construction material was diverted from landfills.
- The structure has vegetated open space that is greater than the building's total footprint and provides access to three bus lines and 46 bike racks.
