Governor Cuomo Announces \$210 Million Initial Capitalization to Jump Start New York Green Bank

Funding to Leverage Private Sector Financing for Clean Energy Projects

New York Governor Andrew M. Cuomo announced in December \$210 million in initial funding for NY Green Bank, a bold, new market-oriented approach to accelerate clean energy deployment, create jobs, and help make New York communities more resilient and sustainable. The NY Green Bank is expected

to open for business and offer its first financial products in early 2014. Governor Cuomo proposed the creation of a \$1 billion Green Bank in his 2013 State of the State address as the financial engine that will mobilize private investment in clean energy projects. The NY Green Bank will partner with private sector institutions by providing financial products such as credit

enhancement, loan loss reserves, and loan bundling to support securitization and build secondary markets. These products will support economically viable clean energy projects that cannot currently access financing due to market barriers, such as federal policy uncertainty, insufficient performance data, and the lack of publicly traded capital markets for clean energy. Virginia Tech's Margie Lawrence Credited with Bringing Residence Hall Housekeeping Into 21st Century

Margie E. Lawrence joined Virginia Tech in 1980 and has worked her way up the professional ladder from a janitorial supervisor to the assistant director for housekeeping and furnishings for the residence hall system. As part of her day-to-day responsibilities, Lawrence supervises 92 people, including 75 housekeepers, six special project employees, seven supervisors, one assistant manager, and three managers. The group is responsible for cleaning 2.2 million square feet of residence hall space. In addition to being tasked with writing housekeeping policy and procedures, maintaining discipline and order, overseeing the Integrated Pest Management



Program, and developing training programs for her staff, Lawrence also interacts with vendors and tests and evaluates the latest cleaning products and equipment. Among her more recent accomplishments, she is credited with spearheading the state's effort to transition from harsh cleaning chemicals to biodegradable, sustainable products.
