staffing levels, salaries, and performance levels for custodial, grounds, maintenance, and other functional areas.

## **Chronicle Publishes Report on Future of Academe**

The *Chronicle of Higher Education* has published a report, *2026 The Decade Ahead*, that synthesizes expert analysis and research to examine the future of the higher education enterprise. The report identifies 3 key changes in coming years:

•The next generation of students: why a major increase in applicants' racial and socioeconomic diversity will force colleges to rethink their admissions strategies.

•Tenure policies: why Baby Boomers remaining in their teaching positions for longer than expected will lead to a scrutiny of tenure policies nationwide. •Classrooms of the future: how advancements in technology and skepticism surrounding the value of college educations will reshape curricula and course content.

#### U.S. Green Building Council Announces LEED Pilot Credit: Building Material Human Hazard and Exposure Assessment

The U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) announced a new LEED pilot credit—**Building Material Human Hazard & Exposure Assessment**, which encourages project teams and manufacture rs to assess human health related exposure scenarios for products during their installation and use phases. "LEED v4, the latest version of the LEED green building system, has begun a shift in how we think abouthealth and building materials," said Scot Horst, chief product officer, USGBC. "We have a focus on transparency and optimization so specifiers can know what they are using and can reward innovation. But understanding how a material impacts human health require

innovation. But understanding how a material impacts human health requires a full understanding of hazard and exposure. The new pilot credit is a first step toward evaluating exposure by encouraging product inventories in order to prioritize decision making." <u>Read more about the new LEED credit.</u>

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
