

Two Great Collaborations Bring Two Great Resources




APPA is pleased to announce the recent publication of two new books, both of which are fully revised editions of earlier resources.

The Building Commissioning Handbook was copublished by APPA and the Building Commissioning Association (BCxA).


Environmental Management Guide for Educational Facilities was co-published by APPA and the Campus Safety Health and Environmental Management Association (CSHEMA).

APPA Leadership Roles are Open for Nominations and Applications


