ISO TAG Meets at APPA

APPA hosted a meeting of the U.S. Technical Advisory Group (US TAG) to ISO Technical Committee 267 – Facilities Management on June 26. The US TAG is responsible for preparing and submitting contributions and input on behalf of the United States to the ISO Technical Committee. Its members include facilities officers from the Federal Facilities Council, both public and private sector facilities owners, higher education facilities organizations, suppliers, consultants, and international facilities membership organizations, including APPA and IFMA. The standards developed by Technical Committee 267 are international standards for facilities management available for adoption by nations and the FM industry in various areas of the world, most notably Europe, the U.S., Japan, and Australia.

Embry-Riddle's New Residence Hall Features Innovative Techniques

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University's new 650-bed student residence hall, which opened in January at its Daytona Beach, FL, campus, is a \$25 million, 145,000-square-foot facility designed by PQH Group.

Tab Glass & Window selected and installed 10,000 square feet of windows, 15,000 square feet of curtainwall, 14 door leaves, and an airfoil fin that extends 10 inches from the building from Tubelight. The doors' steel tie-rod construction can be modified, disassembled, or resized in the field. The curtainwall systems use exterior screw-applied pressure bars to secure glass in place and snap-fit with a cover plate to conceal fasteners. The framework provides structural performance that reduces



the need for steel reinforcing. The curtainwall can withstand winds of up to 90 miles per hour. Viracon glass maximizes the window-to-wall ratio and exceeds current domestic energy code requirements. Viracon VUE-30 low-e glass delivers a solar heat-gain coefficient of 0.18.

NACUBO/APPA Key Facilities Metrics Survey Now Available

2016-17 Survey Will Open in August



As NACUBO and APPA continue to collaborate to raise consciousness about basic key facilities metrics for the fourth year, the NACUBO/APPA **Key Facilities Metrics Survey** saw a record number of participants: 329 institutions, a 20% increase over last year's survey. The goal is for campus finance and facilities professionals to be in alignment on several important annual consumption metrics – Electrical/Btu, Water Consumption, Waste Stream Output, Electrical, and Carbon Footprint.

Campuses reviewed individual results and outliers and final results have been posted on the APPA website, with a summary and link on the NACUBO website. On the APPA website, campuses have the flexible choice to create whatever ratio is best to explain their consumption issues – by Carnegie class, region, gross square foot, or FTE.

The survey for the 2016-17 timeframe opens in July and will close on December 18, 2017. Be sure to participate, and invite your peer institutions to do so as well.

Expanded FPI Report Now Available for Survey Participants and Interested Colleagues

APPA's 2015–16 expanded web-based **Facilities Performance Indicators (FPI)** report is now available for both survey participants and non-participants to purchase. The FPI report empowers educational facilities professionals with the vital data, statistical references, and reporting tools they need to measure operations and performance, identify capital asset realities, and lead a successful facilities strategy that supports an institution's mission and vision



The FPI report can help you make the business case for your facilities needs; address capital asset realities; create a balanced performance score card based on critical data findings; and compare and contrast your facilities operations with other institutions.

This is the only report readily available on the costs and practices of facilities operations at educational institutions. Based on an annual survey of colleges, universities, K–12 organizations, and other educational entities, the FPI report includes data from nearly 300 institutions allowing extensive comparisons of average costs for different types of space and institutions such as staffing levels, salaries, and performance levels for custodial, grounds, maintenance, and other functional areas.

The report is free to APPA member survey participants; \$500 for APPA institutional member/non-survey participants; and \$895 for APPA nonmember/survey participants.

BuildingDNA Secures Partnership with Jacobs Engineering

<u>BuildingDNA</u>, which offers visual intelligence for smarter, safer buildings, has secured a letter of intent (LOI) partnership with major APPA Thought Leaders Series co-sponsor <u>Jacobs</u> to pursue national and international smart city opportunities.

"Jacobs will look to BuildingDNA for their expertise related to smart and connected building management efforts," said Ryan Mulligan, urban planner with Jacobs Engineering.

BuildingDNA's Internet of Things (IoT)-based platform, Intrabuilding Visual Awareness, combines smart visual mapping, connected systems, and predictive/prescriptive analytics via live data feeds, sensors, and cameras. The result enhances situational awareness for first responders and streamlines building operations management.
