PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND CREDENTIALING CAPPA's 2017 Conference to Include Special FPI Seminar

APPA's Central region (CAPPA) will provide leadership and management principles, resources for emerging professionals in the facilities profession, insights into the Facilities Performance Indicators (FPI), and more at its 2017 Technology and Leadership Conference, March 2-3, 2017, in San Antonio, TX, with extra offerings on Tuesday, February 28, and Wednesday, March 1.

This year's conference, to held at the San Antonio Airport Hilton, will begin on Tuesday with Academy on Campus - Level 3, an optional offering with classes on Tuesday through Friday of the conference week. In this program, participants develop and strengthen leadership skills while learning basic principles for organizational and managerial effectiveness. This is a four-day course, and the registration fee is \$1,000.

ASHRAE Publishes User's Manual for 2016 IAQ Standard

A manual to help users navigate the changes in ASHRAE's 2016 ventilation standard is now available. *Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality,* the User's Manual for ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 62.1-2016, includes tables, illustrations, and examples of designing, installing, and operating systems for ventilation in buildings.

"The standard contained changes that [affect] highrise residential spaces, the indoor air quality procedure, laboratory exhaust, and demand control ventilation. The manual provides guidance on how to incorporate those changes and others," said Hoy Bohanon, chair of the Standard 62.1 committee.



Also included is a link to newly revised web-based spreadsheets that aid in ventilation rate procedure calculations.
