## CEFP Recertification: Don't Let Your Certification Expire

**reminder**

APPA's **Certified Educational Facilities Professional** credential (CEFP) must be maintained through a combination of 120 APPA Units that must be earned within a four-year period. If you earned the CEFP but have not attained the 120 APPA Units on or prior to your anniversary renewal date, your CEFP credential will expire immediately. APPA will remove your name from the recognition area on our website and you will not be allowed to use the CEFP designation behind your name and/or title.

If you have earned your CEFP, be sure to keep up with your APPA Units and [enter them into your account here](#). It is your responsibility to keep your account up to date and renew your CEFP prior to the end of your four-year recertification cycle. If your CEFP expires, you will have to take and pass the CEFP exam again.

### Seeking Proposed Changes for the 2019 Editions of the IRC & IECC

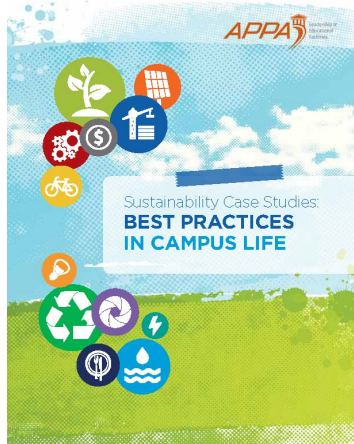


The **International Code Council (ICC)** will soon be accepting proposals for suggested changes for the upcoming editions of the **International Residential Code (IRC)** and the **International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)**. As a part of its monitoring and code advocacy mission, the ICC Work Group operating under the auspices of the **APPA Standards and Code Committee (ASCC)** is canvassing the membership for any change suggestions members may have for either of these two national model codes that typically end up being adopted by your state or municipality as law. Any APPA member may make a suggestion for a change, small or large.
