



APPA Launches New Continuous Learning Series in September





The 2017-18 FPI Survey is Now Open



Tracking Your Facilities Vital Signs

The 2017-18 **Facilities Performance Indicators** (FPI) survey is now open and ready for your data. The FPI is a portfolio of key facilities performance measures gathered by your peers, and addresses the essential questions every facilities professional must be able to answer in order to effectively perform their roles.

Also open is the APPA/NACUBO **Key Facilities Metrics** (KFM) survey. The goal is for campus finance and facilities

professionals to be in alignment on a handful of important annual consumption metrics: Electrical/Btu; Water Consumption; Waste Stream Output; Electrical; and Carbon Footprint.

The deadline for completing both surveys is Monday, December 17, 2018 at midnight Eastern.
