Become an APPA Officer: Nominations are Open for President-Elect

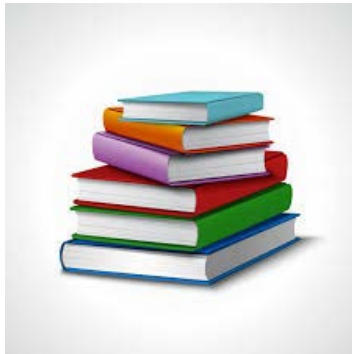
