Governor's Award Nominee David Sciarretta Recognized for Successful Career at Virginia Tech's Steam Plant

When David Sciarretta came to Virginia Tech in 1995, he says he couldn't have imagined the success he would enjoy in his job at the university's <u>Central Steam Plant</u>. A mixed fuel, moderately high-pressure steam generating facility, the plant contains five boilers with superheaters, rated at 80,000 to 100,000 pounds of steam per hour,

which produce steam at 600 psig and 825 degrees Fahrenheit. This high pressure, superheated steam output is matched to a 6,250 kilowatt, 12,470 volt steam turbine powered generator, which was brought online in 1975. This turbine generator reduces the amount of electricity that must be purchased from outside sources, saves Virginia



Tech as much as \$1.5 million a year, and helps reduce net greenhouse gas emissions. The Virginia Governor's Award program exists to publicize the work of best and brightest employees in the state. The "Harvey" continues to be used for



live music, drama, and dance, which requires the cinema screen to be "struck" and stored quickly. The orchestra seating level of the Harvey required a complete seating renovation to meet current egress and ADA requirements and to add comfort. BAM leadership expects that the renovation will help it maintain its worldwide reputation as a leader in artistic innovation. Learn more.
