



DOE and EPA Semi-Annual Regulatory Agenda

This week, many of the federal agencies released their semi-annual regulatory agenda in the *Federal Register*. The agendas are particularly helpful for all those tracking or otherwise involved in various upcoming or pending regulations. They provide approximate timelines for the various rulemakings. While not exact in terms of timing, the agendas offer a general idea of federal actions. Regulatory agendas for two agencies whose activities are relevant to APPA members, the <u>Department of Energy</u> and the <u>Environmental Protection Agency</u>, are attached.

Cuyahoga Community College Westshore Campus Building Achieves LEED Gold Certification

Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) Westshore Campus Health Careers and Sciences building has earned the college its second LEED® Gold certification

from the United States Green Building Council (USGBC). Tri-C is the first community college in Ohio to earn three LEED certifications. The Eastern Campus Health Careers and Technology building earned Gold, the second-highest level of distinction for sustainable design, last July: the Brunswick University Center earned Silver in June. The 65,000-square-foot



building houses classrooms, simulation labs, science labs, campus administration, and a media center around a central collaboration space that

overlooks a protected wetland area. The Westshore Campus building's sustainable features include:

- · Daylight harvesting
- 40 percent reduction in energy use (over current required standards)
- Use of cradle-to-cradle materials on exterior envelope
- Exterior views in 90 percent of occupied spaces
- 47 percent reduction in water usage (over current required standards)
- 90 percent of annual stormwater runoff treated on site
- Native landscaping that eliminates the need for irrigation
- 25 percent recycled content
- 92 percent construction waste diversion
