# Don't Miss the Essentials of Facilities Management Training Seminar June 1-4

The Essentials of Facilities Management Training Seminar is a foundational development program for college student union professionals and other facility administrators. 

## APPA Conducts Survey on Gender-Neutral Restrooms Deadline is April 15!

A recent discussion among members on APPAinfo discussion list focused on the topic of gender-neutral restrooms. A rapidly growing number of colleges and universities are establishing gender-neutral restrooms, and many institutions are in the process of implementing policies requiring that all extensively renovated and newly constructed buildings include at least one gender-neutral restroom. At the ICC code setting hearings, in which APPA will be present to participate, we anticipate that there will be discussion on the impact of gender-neutral restrooms on existing plumbing and building code requirements. # **Educational Facility Grant Program Now Accepting Applications Applications due May 29**

# **LEED Designations Granted to Five Loyola University Chicago** Buildings

Loyola University Chicago has added five green-certified buildings to the list of high-efficiency constructions across its campuses. The United States Green Building Council recently granted Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) designations to the buildings, including three Gold certifications:

 The Institute of Environmental Sustainability received LEED Gold



designation in November 2014. The 217,000-square-foot facility at the Lake Shore Campus includes clean energy and biodiesel production labs, a greenhouse, two aquaponics systems, an ecodome, classrooms, a 412-bedroom residence hall, and the largest geothermal heating and cooling installation in Chicago.

- The Marcella Niehoff School of Nursing at Loyola's Health Sciences
  Campus in Maywood, Illinois, received LEED Gold designation in August
  2013. The four-story, 58,222-square-foot building houses academic
  space, a light-filled atrium, and café.
- The Arnold J. Damen, S.J. Student Center received LEED Silver designation. The 100,000-square-foot facility at the Lake Shore Campus includes dining facilities, a cinema, meeting and worship spaces, and a student-run pub. It features natural ventilation, a green roof, significant day-lighting, dual-temperature radiant panels, and a state-of-the-art building automation system. More than 75 percent of construction waste was recycled or otherwise diverted from a landfill during the building process. The building was granted LEED certification in August 2013.
- Cuneo Hall, an academic building at the Lake Shore Campus, received LEED Gold designation in October 2012.
- de Nobili Hall, home to more than 200 students at the Lake Shore Campus, received LEED Silver designation in July 2014.

# Schneider Electric Enables Lawrence County Schools to Deliver Millions in Energy Savings

Schneider Electric has announced partnerships with two school districts to implement energy efficiency projects that will deliver millions in energy savings, one in Alabama and one in California. The company is working with Lawrence County Schools in Moulton, Alabama to implement an energy savings performance contract that will fund critical infrastructure renovations to improve the district's energy efficiency. The project is expected to generate \$11.7 million in energy savings over the next 20 years – funding the efficiency upgrades in their entirety at no cost to taxpayers. Budget-neutral improvements underway include:

- District-wide building automation, providing centralized control of 4,500 access points
- Renovations and upgrades to over 11,600 interior and exterior lighting components
- District-wide IT enterprise management system to control power usage of 3,700 pieces of equipment

Schneider also is working with the San Marcos Unified School District in San Marcos, California on a Proposition 39 Energy Expenditure Plan to implement energy efficiency upgrades across 18 sites district-wide. This project will deliver more than 1 million kWh annually in energy savings. <u>Learn more</u>.

### **IICRC S520 Draft Standard Available for Public Review**

The Institute of Inspection, Cleaning and Restoration Certification (IICRC) announces that it is revising the IICRC S520-2008 Standard and Reference Guide for Professional Mold Remediation. The IICRC S520 is a procedural standard and reference guide for the remediation of mold-damaged structures and contents. The IICRC S520 is based on reliable remediation and restoration principles, research and practical experience, and attempts to combine essential

academic principles with practical elements of water damage restoration for technicians facing "real-life" mold-remediation challenges. The S520 is written for use by those involved in the mold remediation industry. It is the result of collaboration among microbiologists and other scientists, public health professionals, restoration service companies, cleaning and restoration training schools, trade associations, allied trade-persons, and others. The IICRC S520 draft Standard is available for review and comment until April 27, 2015. Visit <a href="http://iicrc.org/standards/iicrc-s520/">http://iicrc.org/standards/iicrc-s520/</a>.
