### APPA Conducts Convener's Meeting of APPA Cleaning Council Work Group

A Work Group on Cleaning Standards was launched by APPA's Standards and Codes Council on March 4. Over 90 persons from more than 80 institutions were present to initiate discussion and to help define the efforts of the new work group, which will closely examine the possible impact of an ANSI cleaning standard activity proposed by the Simon Institute. The work group process will identify the benefits and/or disadvantages that might be realized for APPA members, should the Simon Institute seek to establish an ANSI U.S. standard that defines cleaning and custodial processes based on intellectual property and copyrighted training materials published by ManageMen Inc. There are significant concerns among many APPA member institutions that an ANSI cleaning standard, as proposed by the Simon Institute, could increase maintenance costs and reduce flexibility in the delivery of custodial services. ### New Jersey's Kean University and Ocean County College Join Programs in one Sustainable Building

The Gateway Academic Building on the 275-acre campus of Ocean County College (OCC) in Toms River, New Jersey, has just been completed—the result of a strategic partnership between OCC and Kean University. Designed to achieve LEED Silver, the five-story, 74,000 square-foot facility is the tallest in Ocean County. It houses a 210-seat lecture hall, four seminar rooms, offices for 56 faculty members, 25 classrooms, two laptop computer labs, two 26-seat conference rooms, a 50-seat multipurpose room, and more.

Walls of windows take advantage of natural light and views of the ocean. The building is called "Gateway" because it divides the new and old OCC campus and offers new degree opportunities through the partnership. It is the first installment in the Kean Ocean partnership. ## **Survey: Many HVAC Contractors Unprepared for 2015 Efficiency Standards**

A majority of U.S. contractors are unprepared for upcoming regulatory changes in residential air-conditioning and heat pump systems, according to a recently released survey conducted by a private company. The study of 472 contractors found that 74 percent of contractors were unaware of the forthcoming 2015 regional standards for residential unitary air-conditioning and heat pump systems. Nearly 80 percent of contractors were unaware of 2015 part-load efficiency requirements for light commercial split, package, and rooftop systems. Further, 84 percent were unaware of the 2015 chiller standards. Unlike regulatory changes made in 2005, the 2015 changes will affect both residential and commercial efficiency standards. Learn more.
