ASU Plans to Expand Library Resources



Arizona State University (ASU) will invest more than \$100 million over the next few years to renovate and rethink its libraries as part of efforts to serve both students on-campus and a growing online study body. ASU plans to close the Hayden Library on its Tempe campus later this year for a two-year renovation and will work on expanding library resources and services at the same time, in recognition that the majority

of users are online. The university received a \$50,000 grant from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation last year to support some of this work.

UMass Amherst Opens Net-Zero Energy Building

The University of Massachusetts Amherst department of economics has opened Crotty Hall, a new 16,800-square-foot net-zero-energy building housing 35 offices and four conference rooms that will use about one-fifth the energy of the average office building.

Built with a \$10 million grant from an anonymous donor, the building is designed to produce as much energy as it consumes. The walls, roof, and foundation are heavily insulated, and the roof is covered with high-efficiency solar voltaic panels. Eight geothermal wells reach about 450 feet deep to draw heating and cooling water that remains a near-constant 52 degrees all year. Heat is transferred by radiant panels on the ceilings, and all windows have three layers of glass. Sensors contribute to energy conservation.

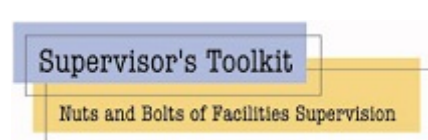

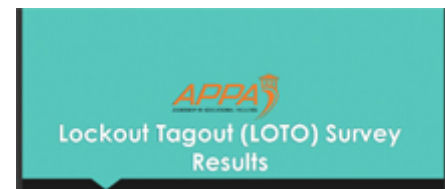

APPA 2017 Lockout-Tagout (LOTO) Survey Results Now Available

The APPA Standards and Codes Council (ASCC) conducted a survey of the APPA membership regarding LOTO. [Results](#) of the survey have been posted on the APPA website under [Standards and Codes](#).

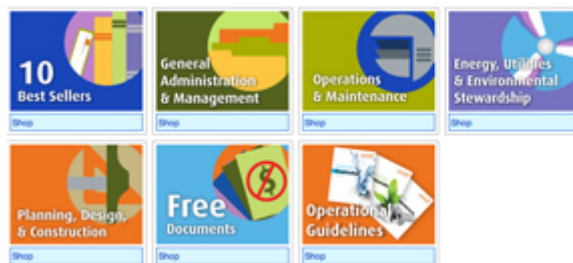
Highlights include:

- 96.13% of the institutions have LOTO procedures in place for controlling hazardous energy
- 88.46% said physical plant/maintenance is responsible for executing LOTO procedures
- Of the OSHA-required procedures, 96.09% use lockout devices and 90.55% use tagout devices
- 42.21% said their institutions are "highly confident that [they are] addressing all compliance requirements" and 46.5% said "consistency in updating and maintaining records and inspection reports is a challenge"
- 66.67% said benefit from additional information and training from APPA regarding obligations of physical plant/facilities organizations relating to OSHA LOTO requirements and regulations. Most helpful would be a webinar, 74.65%; APPA whitepaper, 40.14%; and APPA conference session, 29.9%

USBGC Releases 2016 Sustainability Report

The U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) has released its new Sustainability Report. The report provides valuable metrics and key benchmarks for the impact of sustainability on energy use and waste management.



The report details programs implemented for the 2016 Greenbuild International Conference & Expo in October 2016, through a review of objectives, goals, and best practices. Case studies provide detailed overviews of sustainability strategies and initiatives, including waste diversion, attendee and stakeholder engagement, the impact of water, performance tracking improvements, and community advancements. Highlights include a record-breaking waste diversion rate of 90 percent and several first-year restoration initiatives.

The report shares the progress of seven sustainability objectives at Greenbuild:
