January APPA U Registration Opens November 5




Mark your calendars to reserve your seat for APPA's foundational professional development programs—the <u>Institute for Facilities</u>

November 8 APPA Webinar Focuses on Refurbishing Air Handling Units



The next session of APPA's popular webinar series will discuss and educate attendees about NFPA 90A and ASHRAE 62.1 compliance as it relates to air handling units (AHUs).

More specifically, the focus of the discussion will be on NFPA 90A and why it's the law. We will outline common practices specific to air handling unit repair and maintenance that are not compliant with NFPA 101: Life Safety Code, the genesis of nearly all means of egress and life safety criteria codes used in the United States, of which NFPA 90A is a part. In addition, we will discuss requirements specific to ASHRAE 62.1 and the design and operation of HVAC drain pans to ensure acceptable indoor air quality.
